## Gold Level



### How you get there

- Four (4) Silver Certificates

### Rewards

- Certificate presented at Friday assembly
- Invited to a special morning tea with the Principal

## Silver Level



### How you get there

- Three (3) Blaxcell Blues

### Reward

- Certificate presented at Friday assembly

## Blue Level



### How you get there

- Five (5) Grinners
- Grinners may be awarded for following the school rules

### Reward

- Blaxcell Blue presented during class

## Green Level



### How you get there

- All students start at Green Level at the beginning of each term

### Reward

- Reward Time will be held at the end of each term for all students who have not been on a negative level



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## Orange Level

### How you get there

- Three (3) Behaviour Strikes
- Commit a moderate level offence

### Consequences

- One lunchtime detention
- Student will be monitored through a Behaviour Card
- Two Levels in a term will result in one week exclusion from PSSA
- Two Levels in a term will result in exclusion from Reward Time
- If positive behaviour is maintained for one week, student will go back to Green Level
- If further misbehaviour occurs whilst on Orange Level, student may be moved onto Red Level

## Red Level

### How you get there

- Three crosses whilst on Orange Level
- Commit a moderate/major offence

### Consequences

- Two lunchtime detentions
- Student will be monitored through a Behaviour Card
- Two Levels in a term will result in one week exclusion from PSSA
- Two Levels in a term will result in exclusion from Reward Time
- If positive behaviour is maintained for one week, student will go back to Green Level
- If further misbehaviour occurs whilst on Red Level, student may be moved onto Purple Level

## Purple Level

### How you get there

- Three crosses whilst on Red Level
- Commit a moderate/major offence

### Consequences

- Five lunchtime detentions
- Student will be monitored through a Behaviour Card
- Meeting with Deputy Principal involving parents/guardians and student
- Attendance at excursions, camps and performances may be subject to an individual risk assessment whilst on Purple Level
- One week exclusion from PSSA
- Student will be excluded from the end of term Reward Time
- If positive behaviour is maintained for one week, student will go back to Green Level
- If further misbehaviour occurs, then student will remain on Purple Level and the school may consider suspension

## White Level

### How you get there

- Student returning from suspension

### Consequences

- Return from Suspension Meeting involving student, parent and Deputy Principal/Principal
- Conditions of Return are discussed, agreed and signed by all involved
- Student will be monitored through a Behaviour Card
- Attendance at excursions, camps and performances may be subject to an individual risk assessment whilst on White Level
- One week exclusion from PSSA
- Student will be excluded from the end of term Reward Time
- If further misbehaviour occurs and 'Conditions of Return' are not adhered, then the Principal may implement another short/long suspension
- Further action may be implemented at the discretion of the Principal
- If positive behaviour is maintained for one week, student will go back to Green Level
