How to Make a Paper Fish


Materials:

- ★ Paper fish template
- ★ Colouring pencils / markers / glitter to decorate
- ★ Black marker or pencil
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Glue

Instructions

- 1. Decorate the fish template with coloured pencils / markers / glitter or whatever other materials you have at home to make your fish look colourful and shiny!
- 2. Cut out the pieces to make the fish.
- 3. Fold the body piece of paper over and glue together the tail pieces, making sure the decorated side is facing outwards. If they don't fit together neatly just trim the template so they do.
- 4. Glue on the fins to the inside of the body piece.
- 5. Glue on the eyes.
- 6. Draw a smile.
