- I can say what the parts do.





















We have learned these parts of the head. Ask someone to help you check whether your answers are correct.

How many of each part do you have? Write the Chinese number in the empty box.

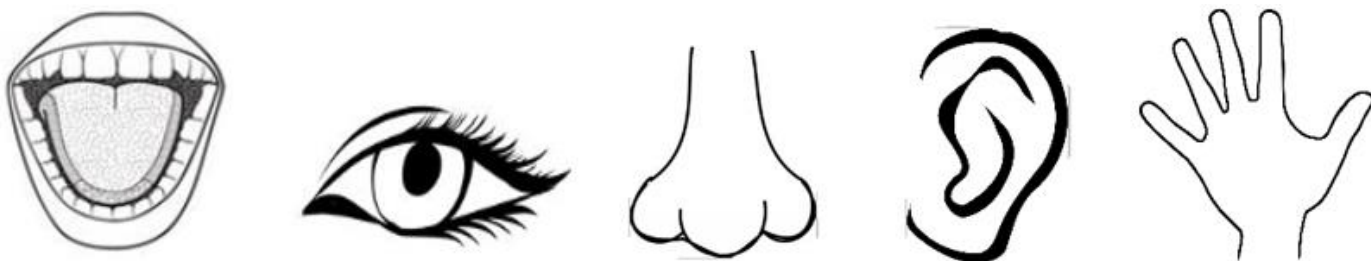
