**MISS BONTHORNE & MS ALMIR**

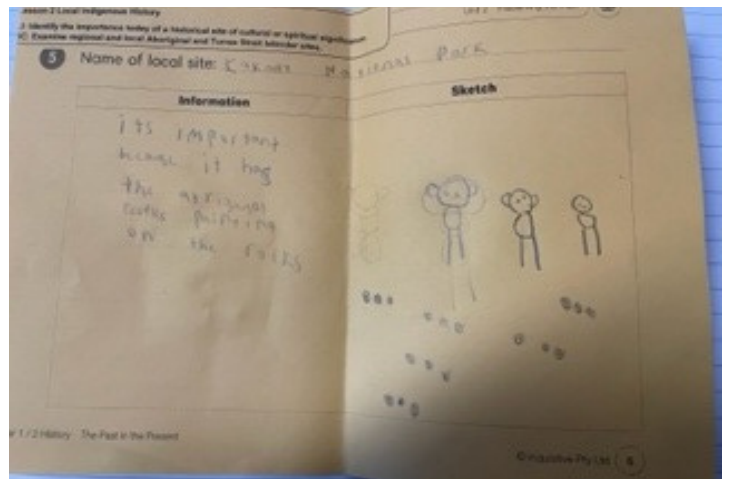
2B have been working hard during our Maths lessons this week! Here we are working on adding and subtracting.

2E have been learning about money this term. Here students are learning to count groups of money and record how much they have in their workbook. Keep up the amazing work boys and girls



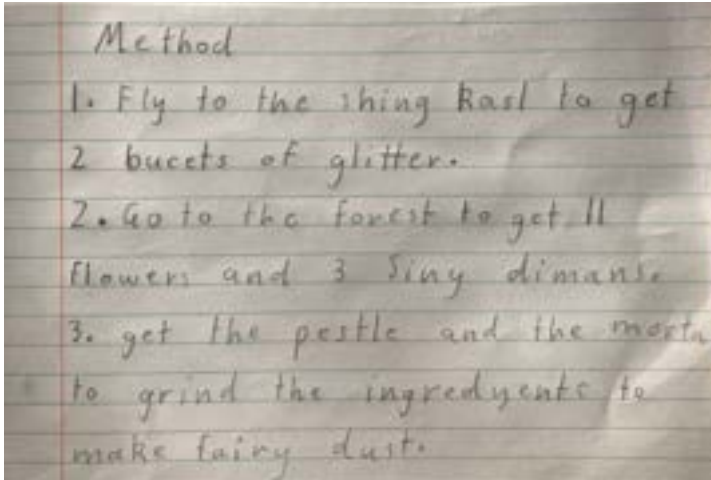
